St. Pius V School Policy on Admission

“Every Person, as a child of God, regardless of race, condition, or age, has equal dignity and an inalienable right to an education. Therefore no qualified student will be denied admission to our schools on the basis of race, color, or national origin.”

(Administrative Handbook, Article 5: Section 5010.1)

Catholic Parents who can demonstrate clearly their support of and commitment to the purpose of Catholic Schools have priority in enrolling their children therein the space permits.

Diocese of Orange Policy on Admission

1. Parents agree to support the spiritual, academic and financial standards of the school.
2. Records needed are: Birth certificate, Baptismal certificate, last two years of report cards, and national test scores (Iowa, CTBS, SRA, Stanford). Current and up to date IMMUNIZATION records must be submitted. Academic grades must be average or better, and conduct grades must be above average.
3. The State requires a PHYSICAL upon entering First Grade.
4. Kindergarteners/First Graders will be tested. Students applying for grades 2 – 6 *may be* tested and interviewed.
5. Grades 2 – 8 need a letter of recommendation.
6. Junior High students and parents will be interviewed and student *may be* tested.
7. All new students are accepted on probation.

Volunteer Program

Parents must get involved and take a specific role in the school by participating in fund raising activities and service to the school. In order to ensure a more just distribution of support services, each school family is required to volunteer 40 hours of work per school year. For those unable to find available time, an additional \$32.00 per month is assessed to their tuition payment.
